There is a strict limit of 150 places at each disco. Bookings are taken on a first come, first served basis.

If you are unable to book online at this time, you can ask someone else to book on your behalf. They will need to know the website address, the event code, your child's name and class and your email address, name and emergency phone number.

If you are unsuccessful in booking a space for your child and would like their name to be added to the waiting list, please contact the school office.

Payment requests will start to be issued from Tuesday 22nd January onwards via the PayOurSchool system. The School Office will work through these during the week.

If payment has not been received by 10am on Tuesday 5th February, your child's name will be removed from the list and their place allocated to a child on the waiting list. If you are experiencing problems paying online, please contact the school office as soon as possible.

Children attending the Years 1, 2 and 3 disco will be taken from their classrooms to the disco at the end of the school day and will be registered before entry. They may bring a change of clothes in to school. Refreshments and novelty items will be available to purchase – we suggest that children bring no more than £3.
